The First Amendment to Option Agreements (Solar Energy Lease) for the HID and Adams Reservoirs were presented for consideration. After Alan Ozuna explained the reason and effect of the amendment to the original agreement, a motion was made by Levi Burns and seconded by Leonard Simmons to approve the amendments. The motion passed.

An offer by Dung Dang Nguyen to purchase .225 acres of excess right of way adjacent to blocks 27 and 26 Dixieland #1 subdivision was presented for consideration. After a short discussion a motion was made by Leonard Simmons and seconded by Keith Adams to accept the offer and sell the right of way for \$7,727.66 plus legal and filing fees. The motion passed.

An offer by Robert Conchola of \$5,000.00 to purchase 0.76 acres of excess right of way and 0.30 acres of easement out of block 11 Palm Subdivision was presented for consideration. After a short discussion of the value, based on the Districts policy for determining land values, a motion was made to reject the offer from Mr. Conchola and approve the sale based on the Districts calculated value of \$6,486.76 plus legal and filing fees.

Alan Ozuna reported on legal issues of the District. No action was taken.

The current water allocation report was presented. The Manager reported the number of outstanding water orders and the current water in storage. After a long discussion on when to curtail accepting water orders for District water, a motion was made by Leonard Simmons and seconded by Keith Adams to stop taking water orders for allocated District water as of 10 am September 27,2023 and continue to take water orders for privately owned contract water. The contract water is to be delivered with a water duty of 1:1. The water duty is to be reviewed at the next regular Board meeting. Also, issue a letter to all lawn water contract holders stating that all lawn water contracts are suspended until the District has sufficient water to reinstate the contracts. The motion passed.

Letter to lawn water contract customers:

Dear Lawn Water Customer,

Due to environmental conditions and Mexico's refusal to release U.S water from their dams, the Harlingen Irrigation District has reached a critical stage in our water supply. The District does not expect this situation to change in the near future and therefore the District's Board of Directors has issued an order to suspend all Lawn Water Contracts until the critical water situation improves. Because of this suspension, the District is giving you the option to not pay your 2024 Lawn Water Contract bill. If you have already paid your bill, you have the option to leave the payment on your account or be refunded the amount paid. The District will not disconnect lawn water valves unless it is determined that the customer is continuing to irrigate their yard. If the customer is caught irrigating, the lawn water valve will be removed and no further service will be allowed on the property.

The District will be shutting off all pipelines and securing canal gates to reduce the amount of losses in our system, however we must continue to deliver water to the City of Harlingen and some farmers that still have water. Because of this water may be available in the system that feeds your lawn. We are asking that all customers refrain from using water even if it is available to your area. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated as we continue to work through this water shortage.
